C1 – meeting online - Short term joint staff training event

The **first CIVIC joint training event (C1)** is centered on the exchange of good practices as a learning resource.

It will focus on a joint learning experience and an exchange between the participants.

The meeting is focused on the training curriculum on housing and mental health for local communities, produced by the HERO project.

The aim of the meeting is to discuss and share the structure of the Tutorial of the training Curriculum on housing and its approval. The expected output is the tutorial of the Curriculum. (About 3000 characters, spaces included)

The Italian and Croatian partners are in charge of the training on the curriculum and the other partners will contribute to the exchange of experiences giving feedback on the Curriculum, starting from one's own experiences (also with other groups, such as: migrants, the elderly, people affected by physical or intellectual disabilities and addictions).

The debate will involve everyone and will be supervised in order to develop the Tutorial.

A first draft of the Tutorial will be shared and approved at the end of the two day meeting.

C1 Learning goals:

Knowledge: at the end of C1 the participants will learn from the training curriculum and the reciprocal experiences on educational pathways related to housing and mental health.

Skills: participants will be able to use the training tools described in the training curriculum

Competence: participants will be encouraged to integrate the training Curriculum in their working context, with CIVIC target groups. They will be more competent in collaboration in an EU context.

C1 Outputs: 1. Curriculum tutorial. 1st draft; 2. List of experts in the training Curriculum on housing and mental health (participants of the training)

After C1 event, each partner will take care of promoting the outputs produced, locally and / or internationally.
